

# WR Transported 13 Million Tonnes By Its 6437 Rakes Of Goods Trains



Ahmedabad, Despite the partial lockdown, Western Railway's Parcel special trains have continued to transport all types of essential material to various parts of the country, especially medicines & medical goods as a prime need in present scenario. In continuation to this, on 16th June 2020, three parcel special trains, including a milk rake left from WR. One parcel special train left from Bandra Terminus to Ludhiana and the

other from Dewas to Jabalpur. A milk rake also left from Palanpur to Hind Terminal. Meanwhile, Western Railway has transported till now, various essential commodities weighing more than 13 million tonnes by its 6437 rakes of goods trains, even during the difficult time of lockdown.

According to a press release issued by Shri Ravinder Bhakar - Chief Public Relations Officer of Western Rly, since 23rd March to 15th

June, 2020, commodities weighing more than 57,500 tonnes have been transported by Western Rly through its 338 parcel special trains, which included agricultural produce, medicines, fish, milk etc. The earnings generated through this transportation, has been approx Rs 18.44 crore. During this period, forty three milk special trains were run by Western Rly, with a load of more than 32 thousand tonnes and 100% utilization of the

wagons, generating revenue of approx Rs 5.51 crore. Similarly, 290 Covid-19 special parcel trains with a load of more than 23 thousand tonnes were also run to transport essential commodities, for which the revenue earned was Rs 11.85 crore. In addition to this, 5 indented rakes carrying 2378 tonnes were also run with 100% utilization generating revenue of more than Rs 1.07 crore. He apprised that during the lockdown period from 22nd March till 15th June, 2020, total 6437 rakes of goods trains have been used by WR to supply essential commodities amounting to 13.02 million tonnes. 12,767 freight trains have been interchanged with other zonal railways, in which 6,398 trains were handed over and 6,369 trains taken over at different interchange points. 339 Millennium Parcel rakes of Parcel Vans / Railway Milk

Tankers (RMTs) have been sent to different parts of the country to supply as per the demands of essential items such as milk powder, liquid milk and other general consumer goods. Shri Bhakar stated that the total loss of earnings over Western Railway on account of Corona Virus, has been over Rs 1331 crore, which includes Rs 190.63 crore for suburban section and Rs 1140.54 crore for non-suburban. In spite of this, resulting to cancellation of tickets till now, Western Railway has ensured to return refund amount of Rs. 342.03 crore. It's worth mentioning that in this refund amount, Mumbai division alone, has ensured refund of more than Rs 159.90 crore. Till now, 52.40 lakh passengers have cancelled their tickets over entire Western Railway & have received their refund amount accordingly.

## Husband murdered wife on suspicion of having an extramarital affair

Recently, a new case of crime has surprised everyone. The case that has come up is from Thakurganj. Where on Sunday evening, a young man was murdered by cutting his wife's throat with a knife due to suspicion of having an extramarital affair. Police arrived on receiving information in this case, after investigating the body, started the search for the absconding accused. According to the reports, Mithailal, who lives near the Marimata temple of Thakurganj, used to take care of the family by driving an e-rickshaw. He is survived by his wife Parvati, 35, a son Ranjith

and a daughter. The children say that the father used to suspect that the mother had an illegal relationship with another man. There was often a fight between the two about this. They said that on Sunday, when both of them were playing outside, only then did they hear about this thing. Father murdered his mother by strangling her with a knife. When they reached the room on hearing their screams, they saw that the blood-stained body of the mother was lying on the ground and the father started running out of the room. The children made noise

and tried to call for the local people but, he escaped by throwing stones at everyone. The police arrived after receiving the information, after checking the site of the incident, the body has been sent for post-mortem. In this case, DCP Tripathi told that a blood-stained knife has been recovered from the scene. Two teams have been set up to search for the accused by registering a case of murder.

## 27 year old man commits suicide by hanging

New Delhi, The crime case that has come up recently is that of Malkera Lal Dhaura Colony under Katras police station. A 27-year-old youth Chandan Kumar has committed suicide by hanging himself where he lives. According to the information received, police reached the spot after getting information about the incident, is investigating the matter. In this case, it has also been told that the local people have said that Chandan was an unemployed

youth who used to roam day and night. He used to work for the installation of dish and DTH. His father has died long ago. He also told that the elder brother of the two brothers was a BCCL worker, but the unmarried sandalwood remained separate. He had many types of addiction. In this case, on Tuesday, his partner went to call Chandan, then the door of the room was open.

When he entered inside, he was stunned to see the scene. The young man was found hanging on the roof railing with the help of rope. After knowing the matter, when the people of the incident came to know about the incident, the Katras police were informed about the incident, the police took the dead body in their possession and sent it to Dhanbad PMCH for post-mortem.

## Indian-American businessman charged with COVID-19 relief fraud

New Delhi, An Indian-American owner of several technology companies in the Chicago area has been charged with COVID-19 relief fraud running into USD400,000, federal prosecutors have said. Rahul Shah (51) has been charged in a criminal complaint filed in the Northern District of Illinois with bank fraud and making false statements to a financial institution. An initial appearance in US District Court in Chicago has not yet been

scheduled. According to the complaint, Shah filed a bank loan application that fraudulently sought more than USD400,000 in a forgivable Paycheck Protection Program loan guaranteed by the Small Business Administration under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. In support of the loan application, Shah allegedly caused to be submitted to the lender several false and fraudulent IRS documents.

## Groom creates mayhem, kills minor brother-in-law

Farrukhabad: In a shocking incident, a groom in Uttar Pradesh killed his nine-year-old brother-in-law and ran his SUV over two women and a teenaged girl, leaving them seriously injured, after heated arguments over food served at the wedding. Manoj Kumar and his friends began quarrelling with the bride's relatives over sweets served to them at the wedding in Shamshabad area on Monday night. 'They were inebriated when they started arguing. The elders intervened but they fired at my maternal uncle who escaped unhurt,' said Punit, the bride's brother. He alleged that his younger brother Pranshu, who was serving water to Manoj and his friends, was whisked away by the accused in an SUV. 'While fleeing, they ran their SUV over two women and a teenaged girl, leaving them

with serious injuries. We made several calls to Manoj to return along with Pranshu, but he refused. At 3 a.m. the next morning, he left my brother's body in the village and fled,' Punit claimed. Pranshu's neck had a strangulation mark and his face was disfigured. The injured—Vimla, 50, Mithilesh, 35, and Sapna, 17—were taken to Lohia district hospital in Farrukhabad where the condition of Mithilesh is said to be critical. According to the FIR filed by the bride's father Rampal Jaatav, 'Manoj Kumar drove a speeding SUV over people standing on the roadside and injured three women relatives. My nine-year-old son was also killed by the groom and his friends.' Kamayganj Circle officer Rajveer Singh Gaur said: 'Initial investigation suggests that men from both sides were engaged in a heated argument.

## Mother murders his son in anger, arrested

Kanker, Recently, the case of crime that has come up is under the City Kotwall Kanker police station of Kanker district of Bastar division. Where a mother, upset over drinking alcohol and fights, strangled her son to death. According to the information received in this case, after the murder, she informed the police about the suicide of his son in the police station to mislead. The police, including the women who have cooperated, have also been arrested. According to the information, the police say that the deceased youth Jitendra Nishad was 18 years old from Badepara Vyasakogera. On 11 June, there was a weekly market of village Vyasakogera and on the same day, some of his relatives had come to the deceased's house. In this case, Jitendra along with his cousin Dharmendra Nishad and neighbor Dilip Netam returned home after drinking alcohol. After that, there was a debate between Jitendra and Dharmendra about something and the debate turned into a quarrel when Dharmendra's mother Sharada Nishad tried

to defend. In this case, the drunken deceased Jitendra started abusing his mother Sharada who came to the rescue. Meanwhile, accused Sharada, Dharmendra Nishad's father Arjun Nishad, Dilip Singh Netam's father, late Prahlad Netam, united in anger and started beating Jitendra. After that when Jitendra became half-dead, the three strangled the deceased and hanged him by calling the police station and informed about Jitendra's suicide. As soon as information was received in this case, the team of Kanker City Kotwall reached the spot and started investigating. The police immediately registered a case of murder and questioned Jitendra's mother Sharada in which she confessed her crime by giving full information. Now the police have registered a case of murder under sections 302, 201, 34 against accused Sharda Nishad husband Bhagirathi Nishad, Dharmendra Nishad, and Dilip Netam and arrested the three accused and sent them to jail.
